Objectives

- 1. Introduces viewers to Hawaiian Spinner dolphins and their behavior.
- 2. Explores diurnal patterns of dolphins and how they sleep.

Questions for before watching the program

- 1. What is a mammal and what are some characteristics of mammals? What are the characteristics of fish? Is a dolphin a mammal or a fish?
- 2. Can a dolphin breathe underwater?
- 3. Do dolphins sleep? Do they breathe when they sleep?
- 4. Why do you think they are called "spinner" dolphins?

Discussion for after watching the program

- 1. You need to be patient to interact with wild dolphins. Why?
- 2. What do Spinner dolphins do to earn their name?
- 3. When do Spinner dolphins eat and become most active?
- 4. What are they doing during the day?
- 5. How do dolphins breathe?
- 6. How do dolphins sleep without drowning?
- 7. Internet research: Spinner dolphins feed on squid in the *scattering layer*. What is the scattering layer and how deep do they dive for that?
